Uniform:

At St Mary's we believe children should feel a sense of pride in being a member of our school community. This is reflected in the pride they show when wearing our school uniform. It is our policy at St Mary's that all children should wear school uniform when attending school. As such, please be reminded of our uniform details detailed below. Your support in meeting these expectations is greatly appreciated. Our school uniform can be purchased at The Schoolwear shop, Abingdon Square, Northampton. Can I remind all parents to ensure that their child adheres to the following guidelines:

Uniform for Reception Class:

The children in our Reception Class wear a plain white (non-logo) polo shirt all year round together with the navy school logo jumper for both boys and girls.

Years 1 – 6:

Boys Uniform:

- White cotton shirt and tie
- Navy v-neck sweatshirt inc. school logo
- Grey school trousers
- Grev socks
- Black shoes

Girls Uniform:

- White cotton shirt and tie
- Navy v-neck sweatshirt inc. school logo
- Either a grey skirt or pinafore or grey school trousers
- White socks or grey/black tights
- Black shoes

PE Uniform

We will continue to the routine of children attending school in their PE kits on the days they have PE. As this is in place of the school uniform, it is really important that the **correct**

Breakfast Club and After School Club



We continue to offer our Breakfast and afterschool club this year for all pupils. Please note -It is really important

for health and safety reasons that the children are booked into the club at least the day before they are due to attend, as last year we have a number of children not booked in and this is not in line with the procedures for allowing your child to attend the club.

The school office is here to help you to organise the booking and payment of the club. Should you need to contact the club this should be done via the main school number.

Our Breakfast Club operates from 7.45-8.45am and the cost for session is a flat rate of £4.00. Any parent needing a place in Breakfast Club must contact the school office and then book and pay in advance for the half term.

Our after- school Club operates each day after school from_3.15pm - 5.30pm in the Nest. We provide a variety of fun and relaxing activities for the children to choose from. They are also provided with a healthy snack. The cost of the session is a flat rate of £9 which covers the 2hours 15 mins of childcare facility and refreshments. Full details are available on our website under the parent tab.

Extra Curricular Clubs

We once again have a range of before and after school clubs on offer throughout the term. Information will be shared this week about these and how to book places.

Meet the Teacher Presentations

We will be once again holding our Meet the Teacher Presentations on **Tuesday 12**th **September**. This is a chance for parents to meet their child's new teacher and find out your child's intended learning for the coming year. This will include information on the curriculum, any trips their teachers have planned and about statutory testing in Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6. I hope that parents will find these meetings useful and we look forward to seeing as many of you there as possible. The meetings will take place in the classes at **3.20pm**.

Free School Meals – Pupil Premium

We are all aware of the rising cost of living crisis we are currently living in, please remember the Free School Meals that is available from West Northants Council if you are eligible. The form takes minutes to complete and the information you share on there is confidential and not shared with school. It may be one way of support or help during this difficult time that you may not be aware of. If you think you may be eligible please use the link below for more information.

Please remember this is different to the universal infant free school meals, where every child in EYFS, Year 1 and 2 are eligible for. If you are successful in your free school meal application the school office will be notified by your child's names joining our list and you will be sent further information from us as we offer a bespoke package for our children who are eligible, this includes:

- *support with school uniform if needed
- *£25 worth of reading books, individual to your child
- *all school trips paid for
- *school lunches paid for
- *an opportunity to take part in a sporting club (one a term), or attending breakfast or afterschool club free of charge.

Inhalers and medical needs

Please can I ask that all parents of children who suffer from asthma and have inhalers in school to fill in a Medication Consent Form, which can be obtained from the school office, if you have not already done so. Please provide an inhaler that can be kept in school and ensure that it is in date and clearly marked with your child's name. These should be brought to the school office in the first instance.

Fruit Snack

All Reception and Key Stage 1 children receive a free piece of fruit or vegetable each day that is given out mid-morning. Please remember that children in Key Stage 2 are able to bring in a piece of fruit or vegetable for a mid-morning snack. As a school we aim to comply with the Healthy Eating Standards for schools and I would appreciate your support in encouraging the children to eat healthily.
