## A Letter from The Queen

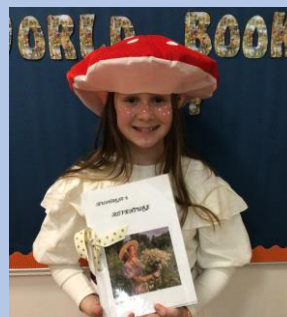
