It has been wonderful seeing the children enjoying the school garden and observing in wonder and awe the growth. We even have many volunteers keeping it watered.

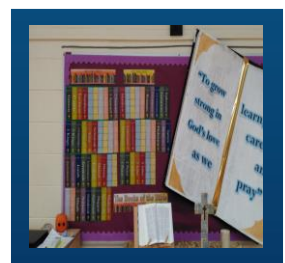
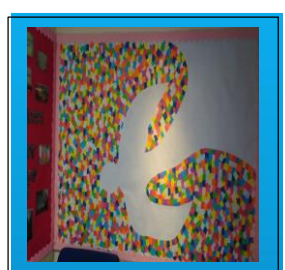
At the weekend, some of our children are making their First Holy Communion, at the Cathedral. Please keep all our children preparing for the Sacraments in your prayers.

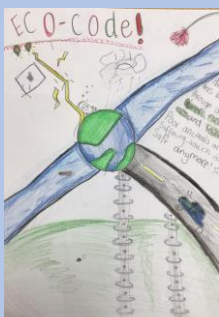
Our May Procession
