They found out the winner of the Eco Stewards badge design and all schools will be receiving their new badges over the next week. They had two guest speakers from Anglian water to talk about a water audit in school and found out that we live in the area of the UK that has the most water deprivation, so our water has to go a very long way. They discussed the impact on habitats and wildlife as we take our water from rivers and lakes. Also a carbon impact from cleaning the water we need. In schools we are looking at ways we can reduce our water use. The Eco stewards are going to be sharing this with the school and encourage all of us to look at simple ways we can reduce water usage, saving our water and our pennies!
