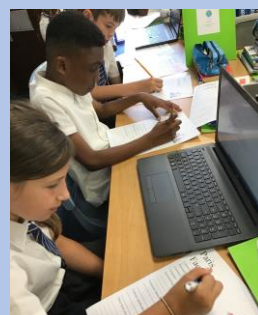
Bethlehem House Sports day Winners
