House of Walsingham Win The House Cup



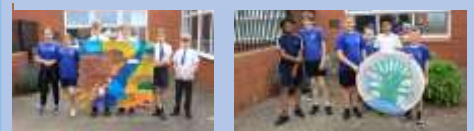
