

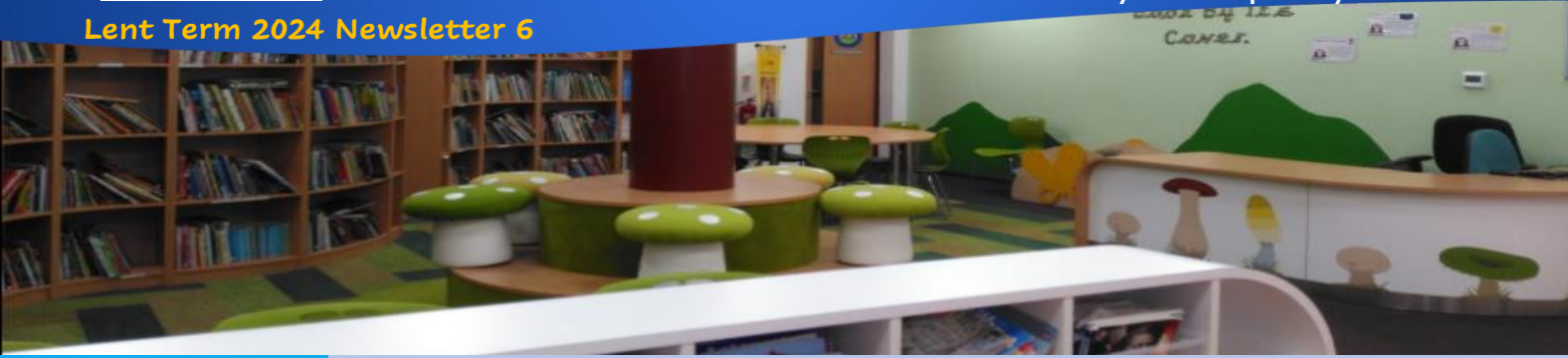

The children sang with great gusto and are to be complimented for excellent participation.

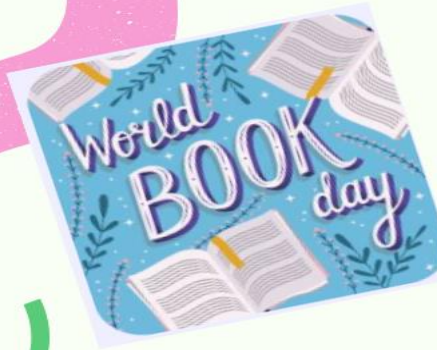
Young Voices 2025
