This week has flown by and the weekend is here again. It's been an eventful week with some exceptional learning being shared with me. I always enjoy celebrating their achievements.

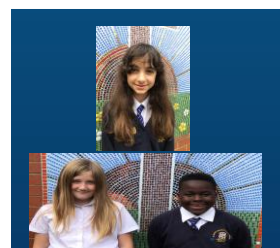
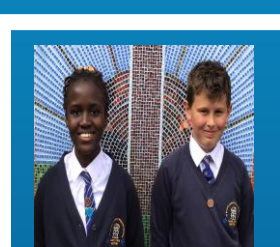
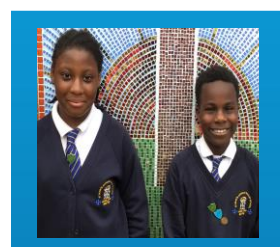
I am delighted that so many children have signed up for the Junior Duke award. I've registered them now and, in a few weeks we will share with you the challenge booklets - so they can get started.
