Thank you so much for your support this week with our "Go Green" Harvest appeal. It was a tremendous success and the children really embraced the environmental message it delivered.

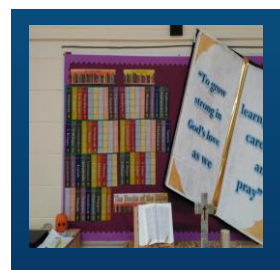
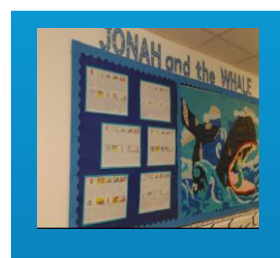
