It has been an autumnal week; the beautiful colours of autumn are clear to see in the school grounds.

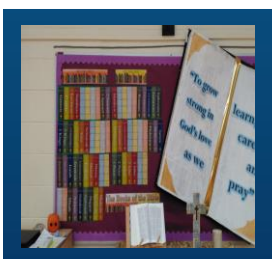
