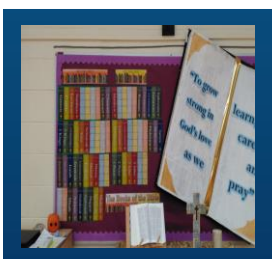
In Reception our young children have been role playing, as palaeontologists looking for fossils as part of their dinosaur dig in class. They were really engrossed in their search and it was a joy to see.
