### *A Message from Mrs Yuen...*

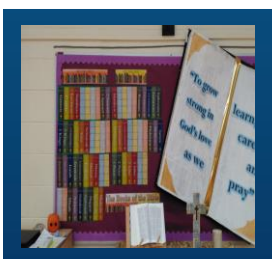
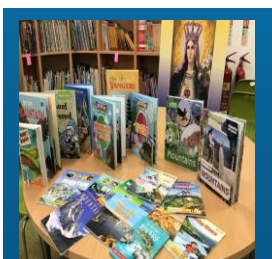
Dear Parents and Carers,
