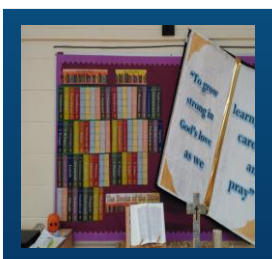
The Science and Eco team explained all about our community effort in enhancing the school garden and creating the prayer space.
