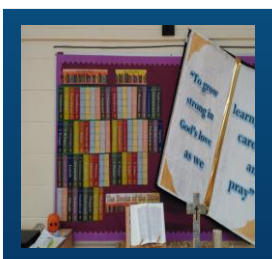

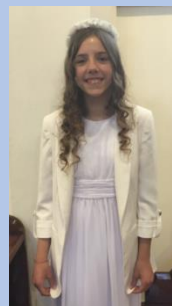


Marathon Kids
